## Session 7 Colossians 3:18- 4:1

ICE BREAKER: What's been the most influential relationship in your life?

Read the Scriptures: <sup>18</sup> Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. <sup>19</sup> Husbands love your wives and don't be bitter toward them. <sup>20</sup> Children obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. <sup>21</sup> Fathers do not exasperate your children, so that they won't become discouraged. <sup>22</sup> Slaves obey your human masters in everything. Don't work only while being watched, as people-pleasers, but work wholeheartedly, fearing the Lord. <sup>23</sup> Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people, <sup>24</sup> knowing that you will receive the reward of an inheritance from the Lord. You serve the Lord Christ. <sup>25</sup> For the wrongdoer will be paid back for whatever wrong he has done, and there is no favoritism. <sup>4</sup> Masters, deal with your slaves justly and fairly, since you know that you too have a Master in heaven. -- Colossians 3:18-4:1 (CSB)
