### Start with Scripture

#### Read Mark 14:66-72

<sup>66</sup>While Peter was in the courtyard below, one of the high priest's maidservants came. <sup>67</sup>When she saw Peter warming himself, she looked at him and said, "You also were with Jesus, the man from Nazareth." <sup>68</sup>But he denied it: "I don't know or understand what you're talking about." Then he went out to the entryway, and a rooster crowed. <sup>69</sup>When the maidservant saw him again, she began to tell those standing nearby, "This man is one of them." <sup>70</sup>But again he denied it. After a little while those standing there said to Peter again, "You certainly are one of them, since you're also a Galilean." <sup>71</sup>Then he started to curse and swear, "I don't know this man you're talking about!" <sup>72</sup>Immediately a rooster crowed a second time, and Peter remembered when Jesus had spoken the word to him, "Before the rooster crows twice, you will deny me three times." And he broke down and wept.
